Two special debate sessions will be part of this schedule.

There is also an opportunity to submit abstracts for poster presentations. This innovation is designed to encourage the participation of researchers, including radiologists in training, and radiology managers. The best papers will be presented in a special poster session.

This programme has been developed by the highly motivated MIR programme committee with substantial support of the French Radiological Society (**Société Française de Radiologie, SFR**), represented by the Conference Chairperson, Professor Elisabeth Schouman-Claeys.

For the first time, there will be an associated **Radiologists in Training Management Course** together with the main conference. The **Junior Radiologists Course** will take place on **Wednesday, September 28th**.

The topics for this workshop have been specifically chosen to help radiologists towards the end of their training as they plan their career after qualification. The combination of the Junior Radiologists Course with the MIR main conference provides a wonderful opportunity for young radiologists to learn about radiology management topics and to network with leaders in radiology from throughout Europe and North America.

MIR prides itself on its friendly and informal atmosphere at its congresses, which are enhanced by interesting social events.

We look forward to seeing you in Nice and would encourage you to submit an abstract.
